These positions are classified as Maintenance Mechanic Senior, state salary grade 8. Location is at the Hyattsville District Court/Multi-Service Center, 4990 Rhode Island Avenue, Hyattsville, Maryland 20781. *These positions are also classified as an essential employee and as such must report to work during his/her regularly scheduled work hours regardless of conditions or when directed to do so by the supervisor.*

DGS is a State agency responsible for operation and maintenance of 55 buildings encompassing 6.2 million square feet of space throughout Maryland. One of our buildings is located at 4990 Rhode Island Avenue, Hyattsville, Maryland 20781 and we are seeking two Maintenance Mechanic Seniors to fill two vacancies there. To be eligible for this position, you must meet these requirements:

**EDUCATION:** Completion of the eighth grade.

**EXPERIENCE:** Four years of experience in any combination of the maintenance trades of which three years shall have been in the trades of electricity, plumbing, steam fitting, refrigeration or air conditioning.

**NOTES:** Applicants may substitute additional experience in any of the maintenance trades on a year-for-year basis for up to three years of the required education.

A degree from an accredited vocational/technical high school with a major in Building Maintenance, or a related field, may be substituted for up to three years of the required general experience.
